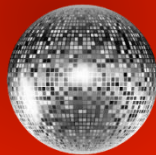

Colour run - Thank you to the PTA for organising our Colour run - it was an amazing afternoon full of joy and fun. 😊



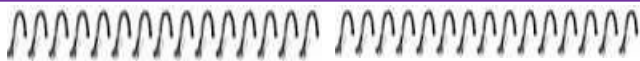
This week in Severn Class...
