Chinese New Year

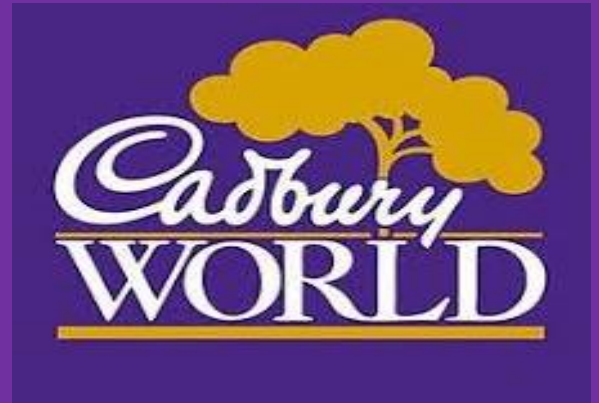

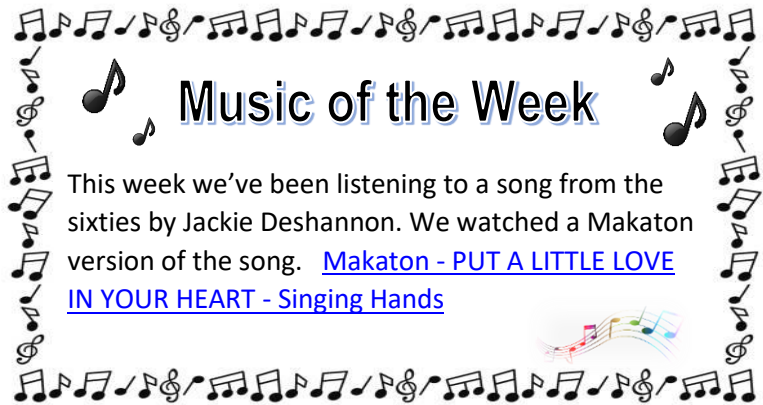

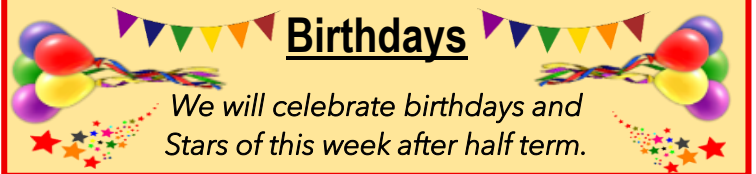
