On Monday, our Wow assembly was all about the Artemis 2 flight around the moon. Here's a quote from one of the astronauts,

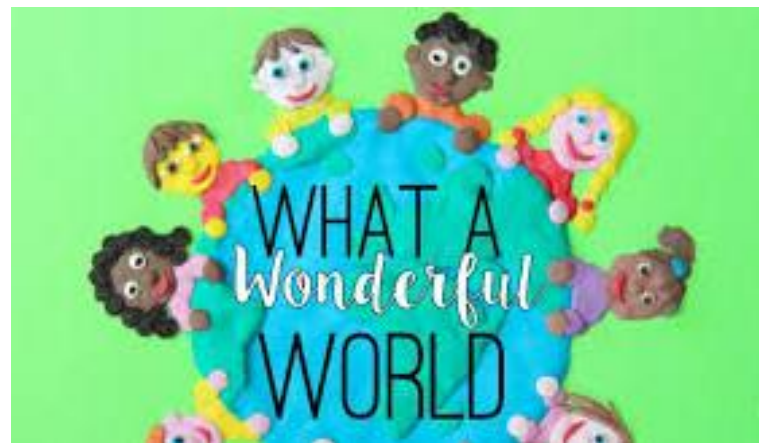
"Our purpose as humans is to find the joy in lifting each other up and when you see Earth from out here, it absolutely reaffirms that."
