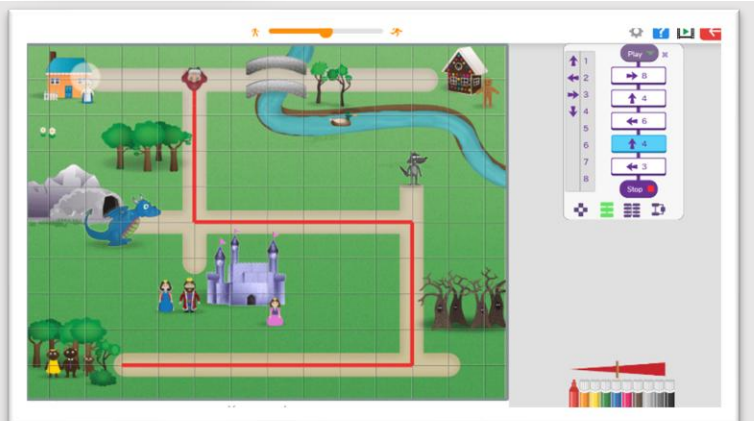
This week in Reception Class...
