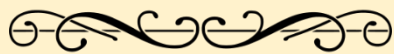

This week in Malvern Class...



This week in RE, Malvern Class have been recapping the Story of Creation. We discussed how this story is shared by both Christianity and Judaism, helping the children to understand the similarities between these two faiths. The class worked together to put the events of the Creation story into the correct order before each group was assigned one of the seven days. Using a selection of percussion instruments, each group created and performed an eight-count piece of music to represent what happened on their assigned day. The children showed great teamwork, creativity, and enthusiasm as they brought the story to life through music.
